ORDER

Pending before the Court is Plaintiff Donald K. Overstreet’s Motion for Judgment on the Administrative Record (“Motion”) (Doc. No. 12), filed with a Brief in Support (Doc. No. 12-1). Defendant Commissioner of Social Security filed a Response opposing the Motion (Doc. No. 15), to which Plaintiff filed a Reply (Doc. No. 16-1). Subsequently, Magistrate Judge Brown issued a Report and Recommendation (“Report”), recommending that the Motion be denied. (Doc. No. 20 at 15.) The Report was filed on May 12, 2014, and provided a period of fourteen days in which either party could file an objection. (*Id.*) Neither party has filed an objection to date.

Upon review of this matter, the Court finds the Report to be well-founded and **ADOPTS** it in its entirety. Accordingly, the Court hereby **DENIES** Plaintiff’s Motion (Doc. No. 12) and **AFFIRMS** the decision of the Commissioner. The Clerk of the Court is **DIRECTED** to close the case.
