ORDER

Pending before the Court is Plaintiff Lori Kay Conrad’s Motion for Judgment on the Administrative Record (“Motion”) (Doc. No. 12), filed with a Brief in Support (Doc. No. 12-1). Defendant Commissioner of Social Security filed a Response opposing the Motion. (Doc. No. 13.) Subsequently, Magistrate Judge Knowles issued a Report and Recommendation (“Report”) recommending that the Motion be denied. (Doc. No. 14 at 27.) The Report was filed on July 22, 2013, and provided a period of fourteen days in which either party could file an objection. (*Id.*) Neither party has filed an objection to date.

Upon review of this matter, the Court finds the Report to be well-founded and **ADOPTS** it in its entirety. Accordingly, the Court hereby **DENIES** Plaintiff’s Motion and **AFFIRMS** the decision of the Commissioner. The Clerk of the Court is **DIRECTED** to close the case.
