Pending before the Court is Plaintiff Rose Buzachero's Motion for Judgment on the Administrative Record ("Motion"). (Doc. No. 13.) Defendant Commissioner of Social Security filed a Response opposing Plaintiff's Motion (Doc. No. 18), to which Buzachero filed a Reply (Doc. No. 19). Subsequently, Magistrate Judge Bryant issued a Report and Recommendation ("Report") recommending that the Motion be denied. (Doc. No. 21 at 14.) The Report was filed on December 30, 2015, and provided a period of fourteen days in which either party could file an objection. (*Id.*) Neither party has filed an objection to date.

Upon review of this matter, the Court finds the Report to be well-founded and **ADOPTS** it in its entirety. Accordingly, the Court hereby **DENIES** Plaintiff's Motion and **AFFIRMS** the decision of the Commissioner. The Clerk of the Court is **DIRECTED** to close the case.
