**QUALITY’S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE REPLY  
IN SUPPORT OF ITS CROSS-MOTION FOR PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

Pursuant to Local Rule 7.01(b), Plaintiff Quality Manufacturing Systems, Inc. (“Quality”) respectfully moves for leave to file a reply in support of its cross-motion for partial summary judgment. [Doc. 40.] The reply will be emailed to counsel for defendant, R/X Automation Solutions, Inc.
