PLAINTIFFS MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUR-REPLY AND
(ALTERNATIVE) MOTION FOR COURT TO RETAIN CLASS/COLLECTIVE
SPECIFIC CLAIMS

Plaintiffs respectfully requests that the Court afford it leave to file the attached sur-reply
in clarification and opposition to Defendants Reply (to Plaintiffs Response in Opposition to
Defendants Motion to Compel) filed on March 5, 2014. Defendants raised several inaccurate
