

ORDER

Before the Court is the Magistrate Judge’s Report and Recommendation (Doc. No. 42) recommending that Sims’ action be dismissed without prejudice for failure to prosecute under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b) and Local Rule 41.01(b). No objections have been filed to the Magistrate Judge’s Report and Recommendation.
