ORDER ADOPTING UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S REPORT

The court referred this matter to the Honorable Earl S. Hines, United States Magistrate Judge, for pretrial proceedings pursuant to General Order 05-07 entered on July 31, 2008.
