**MEMORANDUM ORDER ADOPTING THE MAGISTRATE



Defendants Smith, Gordon and Gilmore filed a motion for summary judgment asserting the affirmative defense of qualified immunity. The Magistrate Judge recommends the motion for summary judgment be granted.
