**MEMORANDUM ORDER ADOPTING THE MAGISTRATE  
JUDGE'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION**

Plaintiff, Sultan Salaam Shareef, an inmate formerly confined at the LeBlanc Unit in Beaumont, Texas, proceeding *pro se* and *in forma pauperis*, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 against Warden Alford.
