ORDER ADOPTING MAGISTRATE JUDGE’S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

On October 22, 2014, the court referred this matter to the Honorable Zack Hawthorn, United States Magistrate Judge, for all pretrial matters. (Doc. No. 19.) Defendants Johnson & Johnson, Janssen Pharmaceuticals, Inc., and Janssen Research and Development, L.L.C. (collectively, “Johnson Defendants”) filed a “Motion for Summary Judgment” (Doc. No. 27) on February 24, 2015. The court has received and considered the report (Doc. No. 41) of the magistrate judge, who recommends the court grant the Johnson Defendants’ motion.
