MEMORANDUM ORDER ADOPTING THE MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

The Magistrate Judge recommends granting plaintiff's claims against defendants Collier and UTMB should be dismissed for failure to state a claim and as frivolous.
