MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Plaintiff, Patrick Robinson, an inmate currently confined at the Jester 4 Unit with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, Correctional Institutions Division, proceeding *pro se*, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 against defendant Sergeant Knock, a correctional officer at the Mark Stiles Unit.
