1. Agendas and Notices

The Agendas are irrelevant to the limited jurisdictional issue before this court, and the information redacted therein is not only irrelevant, but contains descriptions of matters that are proprietary and confidential to HBUS’s business practice. For example, the Agendas list matters related to HSBC entities having no relation to this litigation, and sensitive strategic or legal matters that should not be revealed to third parties. Allowing broad discovery into HBUS’s Board Meeting Agendas would not only allow disclosure of confidential information to third parties, but would potentially inhibit its Board of Directors from acting with efficiency and candor in the future.

2. General Counsel / Legal Reports

Minutes related to General Counsel’s Report and other internal legal issues are irrelevant to the limited jurisdictional issue before this Court. Additionally, information contained therein is confidential, proprietary, highly sensitive, and protected by the attorney work product and attorney client privileges. Broad examples of such protected information includes discussions regarding the effects of changes in certain laws, and inquiries and presentations by regulators. These matters were presented to the Board with the expectation that they be protected from disclosure so that the Board could act with thoroughness and candor. Revelation of sensitive legal matters could severely undermine the competitive advantage and operation of HBUS.

3. Strategic Planning, Development, and Potential Acquisitions

Minutes containing information relating to strategic planning, development, or potential acquisitions are irrelevant to the limited jurisdictional issue before this Court. Additionally, the information contained therein, such as discussions of business constraints and competitiveness is protected from discovery by FRCP 26(c)(7) because it involves confidential research, development, or commercial information. Allowing disclosure of such strategic information would be harmful to HBUS and the various competitive businesses of its many subsidiaries.
