Date	Event
1992 June 15	Libertech is incorporated in Delaware.
1993 June 14	Patent application 08/076,658 is filed (later issues as '352 patent).
1993 Nov 9	Egger assigns patent application to Libertech. (<i>Ex. 3</i>).
1996 May 17	Second patent application 08/649,304 is filed (later issues as '494 and '571 patents).
1996 June 18	Named inventors on second patent application assign rights to Libertech. (<i>Ex. 4</i>).
1996 Aug 22	Libertech changes its name to Site/Technologies/Inc. (<i>Ex. 5</i>).
1997 July 11	Deltapoint purchases all shares of Libertech (a.k.a. Site/Technologies/Inc.). (<i>Ex. 6</i>). Libertech becomes a subsidiary of Deltapoint.
1998 Jan 16	Deltapoint changes its name to Site Technologies, Inc.
1998 Sep 16	Deltapoint (a.k.a. Site Technologies, Inc.) enters into a Bill of Sale with Egger. The Bill of Sale is later recorded with an undated Assignment. (<i>Ex. 7</i>).
1999 Feb 2	Deltapoint files for bankruptcy.
2000 Jun 15	Bankruptcy court enters Order Confirming Debtor's First Amended Plan of Reorganization.
2000 Dec 15	Jeffrey Ait, as Libertech's President and CEO, submits a Certificate of Renewal and Revival for Libertech with the Delaware Secretary of State. (<i>Ex. 10</i>).
2000 Dec 21	Jeffrey Ait files papers with the Delaware and California Secretaries of State to merge Deltapoint and Libertech and leave Deltapoint as the surviving entity. (<i>Ex. 8 & 9</i>).
2004 Jan 06	Final Decree issues in Deltapoint bankruptcy proceedings. Case is closed.
2004 Jan 07	Software Rights Archive, Inc. is incorporated in Delaware.
2005 Feb 11	Egger executes a document in which he purports to be President of Libertech (a.k.a. Site/Technologies/Inc.) and attempts to assign the '352 and '494 patents from Libertech to himself as an individual. (<i>Ex. 11</i>).
2005 Feb 22	Egger attempts to assign his purported interest in the '352, '494, and '571 patents to Software Rights Archive, Inc. (<i>Ex. 12</i>).
2007 May 18	Software Rights Archive, Inc. changes its name to Software Rights Archive, LLC.
2007 Nov 21	Software Rights Archive, LLC. files suit in E.D. Tex. asserting the '352, '494, and '571 patents.
