**ORDER**

Before the Court is Defendants' Cross-Motion to Sever Pursuant to Rules 20 and 21 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. After considering the Cross-Motion and finding that good cause exists for its entry, it is hereby ORDERED that:

The four cases captioned *Wireless Recognition Technologies LLC v. A9, et al.*, No. 2:10-cv-00364-TJW-CE; *Wireless Recognition Technologies LLC v. Nokia Corporation, et al.*, No. 2:10-cv-00365-TJW; *Wireless Recognition Technologies LLC v. A9, et al.*, No. 2:10-cv-00577-TJW-CE; and *Wireless Recognition Technologies LLC v. Nokia Corporation, et al.*, No. 2:10-cv-00578-TJW shall be severed and bifurcated for trial as follows:

The case against Defendants A9.com, Inc and Amazon.com, Inc. shall be tried in one trial; the case against Google Inc. shall be tried in one trial; the case against Nokia Inc. and Nokia Corporation shall be tried in one trial; and the case against Ricoh Innovations, Inc. and Ricoh Company Ltd. shall be tried in one trial.

The Court sets a status conference for \_\_\_\_\_ to address the ordering of the trials. Plaintiff and Defendants should submit briefs addressing the order of the trials by \_\_\_\_\_.
