Dear Michael:

Since our meeting at your offices last year and in light of Interwoven's presentation, we again investigated Interwoven's products and found that the claims of Vertical's U.S. Patent No. 6,826,744 ("the '744 patent") cover Interwoven's TeamSite 2006. "The Definitive Guide to Interwoven TeamSite," which was not previously available to us, facilitated this investigation and helped us prepare the enclosed claim charts. Enclosed you will find claim charts showing the analysis that we performed to reach the conclusion that the claims of the '744 patent cover the TeamSite 2006 product.

During the time since our meeting, a second patent, U.S. Patent No. 7,716,629 ("the '629 patent") issued to Vertical from a continuation of the application for the '744 patent. We have also enclosed claim charts applying this new patent to the TeamSite 2006 product. These claim charts demonstrate that the '629 patent, like the '744 patent, covers the TeamSite 2006 product.

Please examine the enclosed claim charts and the two patents and have Interwoven's technical experts satisfy themselves that the '744 and '629 patents have direct application to Interwoven's TeamSite 2006 product. Also, please feel free to


