[PROPOSED] ORDER ON MOTION OF NON-PARTIES NORTEL NETWORKS CORPORATION AND NORTEL NETWORKS LIMITED FOR A PROTECTIVE ORDER UNDER FEDERAL RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE 26(c) AND 45(d)(3)

Before the Court is Motion of Non-Parties Nortel Networks Corporation and Nortel Networks Limited for a Protective Order Under Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 26(c) and 45(d)(3) (Dkt. No. 152). The Court, having reviewed the motion, Google’s response, and the other relevant papers in this action, finds that the motion should be denied.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** Motion of Non-Parties Nortel Networks Corporation and Nortel Networks Limited for a Protective Order Under Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 26(c) and 45(d)(3) be **DENIED**. It is further **ORDERED** that Rockstar shall substantially complete its production of documents from the computers at issue within 14 days of this order, and that the fact discovery deadline and the trial date shall be extended by at least two months. The Court will issue a separate order setting a new trial date.
