On June 7, 2011, the report of the Magistrate Judge was entered containing proposed findings of fact and recommendations that Plaintiffs’ Motion to Remand (Dkt. #8) be denied.

It is further **ORDERED** that CTX Mortgage Company, LLC is dismissed.
