ORDER ADOPTING REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

The above-entitled and numbered civil action was referred to United States Magistrate Judge Don D. Bush, who subsequently issued a Report and Recommendation that Plaintiff’s multiple motions for injunctive relief be denied. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the combined motion for injunctive relief (docket entries #11 and 12) is **DENIED**. Fed. R. Civ. P. 65. Jackson*, 556 F.3d 351, 360 (5th Cir. 2009).
