## **MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER**

The court, having reviewed Plaintiff Stephen Ray France's ("Plaintiff") "Motion for Attorney Fees and Costs under the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412" ("Motion") (Dkt. #19) and Commissioner's Response (Dkt. #20), wherein the Commissioner states it has no objection to Plaintiff's request, finds that Plaintiff's Motion is well taken and should be granted.
