Dear Mr. Babcock and Mr. McWilliams:

I acknowledge receipt of Cisco System's Request for Testimony and Production of Documents. In response to your request for the depositions and document production to proceed as scheduled on October 31, 2008, I must respectfully decline.

The regulations make clear that a request must be made at least 15 working days in advance of the time by which the testimony or production of documents is to be required. See Disclosure Regulations, $\S6(b)$. Under no circumstance shall a requester be entitled to consideration of an untimely request. See Disclosure Regulations, $\S6(c)$. It is up to my discretion to permit or disallow any exceptions to the 15-day requirement. Id.

I cannot allow any exceptions to the 15-day requirement in this case. I only received a request that attempts to comply with the Touhy regulations yesterday and have not had sufficient time to evaluate its compliance with the regulations or to determine the extent to which any deposition testimony and production of documents would be authorized. Accordingly, no court personnel will be available to testify or provide documents on October 31, 2008.

I expect that I will be able to respond to you early next week regarding your request. In the meanwhile, I respectfully request that you provide me with written confirmation of the withdrawal of the subpoenas no later than 12:00 p.m. tomorrow. I also request that you also provide a courtesy copy of that confirmation to the United States Attorney's Office for the Eastern District of Texas.
