ORDER

Before the Court is Plaintiff’s Emergency Motion for Protective Order (Doc. No. 348). Defendants have filed a response. (Doc. No. 354). A telephonic hearing was held on January 3, 2010.

Upon consideration of the parties’ arguments, the Court **ORDERS** documents regarding the valuation of U.S. Patent No. 5,893,120, which were created due to Richard Nemes’ divorce proceedings, be produced to Defendants. Only documents within the possession or control of Nemes or his divorce attorney, to the extent they exist, are subject to production.

Therefore, the Court **GRANTS** Plaintiff’s Emergency Motion for Protective Order to the extent that Helen Nemes’ deposition is unnecessary in light of the Court’s order to produce the documents described above.
