ORDER

On December 28, 2010, the Court issued an Order (Doc. No. 352) directing Bedrock Computer Technologies, LLC (“Bedrock”) to either produce certain documents or provide supplemental briefing explaining why designated documents should remain privileged. In light of Bedrock’s supplemental briefing on the issue (Doc. No. 356), the Court upholds the privilege claimed with regard to entry 56 and the documents previously designated as “Disclosed to third party (USPTO)¹.” Bedrock has sufficiently explained the invocation of privilege, and as such, these documents should not be produced.

As for entry 292, the Court will hold its decision in abeyance until it receives the supplemental briefing regarding the work product privilege and the date of anticipation of litigation. In the meantime, document 292 need not be produced.
