ORDER

Before the Court is Defendant Yahoo! Inc.’s (“Yahoo”) Emergency Motion to Strike, or Alternatively to Limit, Plaintiff’s Patent Infringement Contentions. (Doc. No. 400). Plaintiff has filed a response (Doc. No. 406), to which Yahoo replied (Doc. No. 426). Upon consideration of the parties’ arguments, Yahoo’s Motion is **DENIED**.

However, the Court finds that, with respect to Yahoo, Plaintiff Bedrock Computer Technologies, LLC’s (“Bedrock”) infringement contentions are limited to the seven versions of Linux kernels identified in their January 12, 2011 revised Infringement Contentions pursuant to P.R. 3-6: 2.4.29; 2.4.31; 2.6.9; 2.6.18; 2.6.22; 2.6.27; and 2.6.29.
