Danielle,

As we discussed on the meet and confer last week, Bedrock is willing to go forward with the deposition of Alexey Kuznetsov after the close of discovery on Monday. I will restate that we are very disappointed that any deposition has to occur after the discovery deadline. However, given that Bedrock was unable to determine if they wanted the deposition of Mr. Kuznetsov until after the late production of communications by yourself and your co-defendants, we agree to let this one deposition occur after the discovery deadline. Given that this discovery delay puts us up against the expert report deadline, we ask that the expert report deadlines be extended a single week.

If you agree, we will file the motion to extend the expert report deadlines. Will you please prepare the motion to allow for the deposition to occur outside the discovery period?

Furthermore, I will reiterate that we need to have enough time to obtain a Visa or the deposition needs to be moved to a country in Europe where a Visa is not required. I will state now that we wish to affirmatively take the deposition of Mr. Kuznetsov. If you contend that we need to file a cross notice of 30 (b)(1) deposition, please let me know immediately.
