DEFENDANT AOL'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO EXCEED PAGE LIMITATIONS TO FILE ITS MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT OF NONINFRINGEMENT OF U.S. PATENT NO. 5,893,120 FOR LACK OF PERFORMANCE

AOL Inc. ("AOL") respectfully files this Motion to Exceed Page Limitations regarding its Motion for Summary Judgment of Noninfringement. Contingent upon the Court granting AOL's Motion for Leave to File A Motion for Summary Judgment of Noninfringement, AOL moves the Court for leave to exceed the 60 page limit prescribed by Local Rule CV-7(a)(3)(A) in its Motion for Summary Judgment of Noninfringement. Bedrock opposes this motion.

The deadline for filing motions for summary judgment was February 8, 2011. On February 9, 2011, after the deadline for filing summary judgment motions, Bedrock made a number of admissions that gave rise to AOL's seeking leave to file its case-dispositive Motion for Summary Judgment of Noninfringement of U.S. Patent No. 5,893,120 for lack of performance. Those admissions are outlined in AOL's Motion for Leave and Motion for Summary Judgment.

Before obtaining those admissions, Defendants collectively filed three motions for summary judgment, totaling 56 pages.¹ When Defendants filed these motions, AOL was unaware of the admissions that form the basis for AOL's current motion. AOL requires additional pages in order to address this newly obtained evidence regarding AOL's noninfringement of U.S. Patent No. 5,893,120 ("the '120 Patent").

The issues raised in the three previous motions for summary judgment are applicable to all of the Defendants collectively. The first was filed on September 10, 2010. The latter two were filed on February 8, 2011 – a day before AOL had the opportunity to depose Bedrock's expert and obtain the admissions that give rise to the motion. As AOL could not have anticipated these admissions, it could not have foreseen the need for additional pages. Furthermore, as the previous motions for summary judgment were filed by Defendants collectively, an AOL-specific motion may have been prejudicial to the remaining six defendants. Due to the number of defendants in this litigation, and the unexpected number of issues that have arisen during the course of this case, AOL requests leave to exceed the 60 page limitation by filing a 19 page motion for summary judgment of noninfringement of U.S. Patent No. 5,893,120 for lack of performance. With this Motion, AOL seeks to significantly streamline the number of issues at trial.

Furthermore, AOL will not oppose any motion by Bedrock to exceed 60 pages to file its opposition to AOL's motion for summary judgment of noninfringement of U.S. Patent No. 5,893,120 if necessary after Bedrock opposes Defendants' other motions for summary judgment.

For the foregoing reasons, the Court should grant AOL's Motion for Leave to Exceed Page Limitations in its Motion for Summary Judgment.

¹ The Defendants collectively filed motions for summary judgment of indefiniteness, noninfringement, and invalidity.
