Before the Court is Bedrock’s Motion to Restrict Hours for Second Trial (Doc. No. 768).

Having considered the parties’ estimates for time for trial, Bedrock’s Motion is **GRANTED**. The Court will allow each side in the Yahoo trial the following times:
