ORDER

Before the Court is the Unopposed Motion to Revise Schedule for Briefing of Motions to Strike and Daubert Motions (Docket No. 1129). First, the Court notes that the trial in this case has been continued from October 2011 until February 2012, which should have afforded the parties plenty of time to draft these motions within the current DCO deadlines. Additionally, there are ten pending motions to strike or *Daubert* motions, several of them presenting duplicative arguments. Finally, the parties present boilerplate language to justify their request for extension.

The Court, with reservations, **GRANTS** the motion to revise the briefing schedule. However, the parties are cautioned against submitting duplicative arguments that effectively sidestep the page limits dictated by the Local Rules. Excessive motion practice and duplicative arguments waste the Court’s valuable resources. Accordingly, the parties are **ORDERED** to meet and confer before submitting any motions subject to this revised schedule to ensure that the arguments submitted do not simply repeat arguments already before the Court. To the extent that such arguments are deemed necessary, the parties shall incorporate them by reference or join the already filed motion.
