**ORDER GRANTING SECOND JOINT UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION
OF TIME TO COMPLETE CERTAIN PRODUCTIONS PURSUANT TO JOINT
AGREED DISCOVERY ORDER AND DOCKET CONTROL ORDER**

The Court, having considered the parties' Second Joint Unopposed Motion For Extension of Time To Complete Certain Productions Pursuant to Joint Agreed Discovery Order and Docket Control Order, and finding good cause supporting it, finds the Motion should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the deadlines for: (a) the production of source code pursuant to Paragraph 2(B) of the Joint Agreed Discovery Order [Docket No. 247] is hereby extended from August 9, 2010 until September 1, 2010; (b) the rolling production of documents as required by Paragraph 2(B) of the Joint Agreed Discovery Order [Docket No. 247] is hereby extended from August 25, 2010 until September 29, 2010; and (c) the exchange of privilege logs pursuant to the Docket Control Order [Docket No. 249] is hereby extended from September 17, 2010 until October 16, 2010. The parties are ordered to begin their rolling production of

documents as soon as practicable, and to use their best efforts to produce documents in advance of the September 29, 2010 deadline for the completion of document production. Except as noted above, no other deadline applicable to this litigation is affected by this Order.
