ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF GOOGLE INC. AND YOUTUBE, LLC <u>FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE CERTAIN DISCOVERY</u>

The Court, having considered the *Unopposed Motion of Google Inc. and YouTube, LLC for Extension of Time to Complete Certain Discovery* from September 29, 2010 (Dkt. 381) until October 29, 2010 for the rolling document productions and from October 16, 2010 (Dkt. 381) until November 16, 2010 for the exchange of privilege logs, and finding good cause, including Google's commitment that it will continue to produce documents to Plaintiff on a rolling basis, supporting it, finds the Motion should be granted.
