## UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FRITO-LAY, INC. AND RENT-A-CENTER, INC. TO COMPLETE CERTAIN DISCOVERY

Defendants Frito-Lay, Inc. and Rent-A-Center, Inc. (collectively "Defendants") hereby move the Court for an extension of time to complete certain discovery. The parties have met and conferred regarding the relief requested herein and this motion is unopposed.

Accordingly, Frito-Lay, Inc. and Rent-A-Center, Inc. respectfully move the Court for an order extending the deadlines for Frito-Lay, Inc. and Rent-A-Center, Inc. to complete their rolling document productions pursuant to Paragraph 2(b) of the Joint Agreed Discovery Order (Dkt No. 247) until October 13, 2010, and to exchange their privilege logs, if any, pursuant to the Docket Control Order (Dkt No. 249) until November 1, 2010.
