As stated in its [charter](#), the mission of the HTML PAG is to study issues for HTML-related Working Drafts and Recommendations raised by the court case of Eolas v. Microsoft and US Patent 5,838,906 in which the court ordered that royalty fees be paid to the patent holder.
