**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXPEDITED BRIEFING ON
EOLAS’ MOTION TO COMPEL DESIGNATION OF RULE 30(B)(6) WITNESSES
FROM AMAZON, EBAY, AND YAHOO! AND FOR YAHOO! TO
PRODUCE THIRD PARTY SEARCH AGREEMENTS**

The Court, having considered Eolas Technologies Inc.’s (“Plaintiff”) Unopposed Motion for Expedited Briefing on Eolas’ Motion to Compel Designation of Rule 30(b)(6) Witnesses from Amazon, eBay and Yahoo and Production of Third Party Search Agreements, which motion to expedite is not opposed by defendants Amazon.com, Inc., eBay Inc. and Yahoo! Inc. (“Defendants”), and finding good cause supporting it, finds the Motion should be granted.
