

I am aware that the Plaintiffs Uniloc USA, Inc. and Uniloc Singapore Private Limited (collectively, "Uniloc") allege that CA directly and/or indirectly infringes U.S. Patent No. 5,490,216, "by, among other things, making, using, offering for sale, selling and/or importing a system, device and/or method for reducing software piracy, reducing casual copying and/or reducing the unauthorized use of software, including without limitation CA's Internet Security Suite Plus 2010 product that permits customers to activate and/or register software."

4. Before the filing of the Complaint in this action, CA offered for sale and sold the accused Internet Security Suite Plus 2010 product in Rhode Island.
