Onyx is a wholly owned subsidiary of Océ Display Graphics Systems, Inc. Onyx develops and markets commercial printing software and solutions for the digital color printing marketplace.



I am informed that the Plaintiffs Uniloc USA, Inc. and Uniloc Singapore Private Limited (collectively, "Uniloc") allege that Onyx directly and/or indirectly infringes U.S. Patent No. 5,490, 216 "by, among other things, making, using, offering for sale, selling and/or importing a system, device and/or method for reducing software piracy, reducing casual copying

and/or reducing the unauthorized use of software, including without limitation Onyx's Imagez product that permits customers to active and/or register software."

4. Onyx sold, either directly or indirectly, products alleged to infringe the patent-in-suit into Rhode Island before Uniloc filed its complaint in this action on September 14, 2010.
