We are presuming that Uniloc intends to file in California before our response is due in Texas, and that you will thus dismiss the Texas action before we have to respond. We also assume that Uniloc will file in Santa Ana (Central District) and note the related cases in its Civil Cover Sheet so that the new case will be administratively transferred to Judge Carter (as our case has been).

Subject to those caveats, this works for us. Please send us a draft Stipulation for the extension for our review.

I hope you are feeling better. I am writing for two reasons. First, do you have a final answer for us as to whether Uniloc will agree to dismiss its action against Symantec in Texas? Please let us know at your earliest opportunity.

Second, Uniloc's response to the California complaint was due this past Thursday, October 28. We have not received any notice from the Court or any indication from Uniloc that Uniloc has filed a response. If Uniloc did not file a timely response, it will want to file a response immediately. While we are amenable to a stipulation to an extension, Symantec would like a final answer regarding Uniloc's intentions in Texas.
