## ORDER ADOPTING REPORT AND RECOMMENDADTION OF UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE

The Report and Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge, which contains her findings, conclusions, and recommendation for the disposition of this case, has been presented for consideration. The Report and Recommendation (Doc. No. 6) recommends that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice for lack of subject matter jurisdiction, but without prejudice to the refiling of Plaintiff's claims in an appropriate state court.
