

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The above-entitled and numbered civil action was assigned to United States Magistrate Judge K. Nicole Mitchell, who subsequently issued a Report and Recommendation that Plaintiff's action be dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution and failure to obey an order of the Court.
