**ORDER GRANTING MICROSOFT CORPORATION’S MOTION FOR PARTIAL
SUMMARY JUDGMENT – NONINFRINGEMENT OF PSVC CLAIMS**

This Court, having considered all papers filed in connection with Defendant Microsoft’s Motion for Partial Summary Judgment – NonInfringement of PSVC Claims, agrees that for the reasons stated in Microsoft’s motion the accused Xbox controller and Xbox Controller S do not infringe claims 5, 6, and 11 of U.S. Pat. No. 5,999,084; claims 1-18 of U.S. Pat. No. 6,102,802; claim 7 of U.S. Pat. No. 6,135,886; claims 1, 3, 6-8, 11, 12, 16-19, 23-25, 28-37, 40-53, and 66-73 of U.S. Pat.
