ORDER

Before the Court is Anascape, Ltd.'s ("Anascape") Unopposed Motion to Allow Kelly Tyler to Testify by Telephone at the July 18 Hearing (the "Motion"). After careful consideration, the Court is of the opinion that the Motion should be **GRANTED**.
