



personally involved in the alleged acts of misconduct, plaintiff has failed to allege facts that demonstrate deliberate indifference. *Estelle v. Gamble*, 429 U.S. 97, 105-106 (1976); *Domino v. Texas Dep't of Criminal Justice*, 239 F.3d 752, 754 (5th Cir. 2001); *Farmer v. Brennan*, 511 U.S. 825, 832 (1994).<sup>1</sup>

ORDER

Accordingly, petitioner's objections are **OVERRULED**. The findings of fact and conclusions of law of the Magistrate Judge are correct, and the report of the Magistrate Judge is **ADOPTED**. A partial judgment will be entered in this case in accordance with the Magistrate Judge's recommendations.
