Mayfield, an inmate confined at the Gib Lewis Unit of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, Correctional Institutions Division, proceeding *pro se and in forma pauperis*, filed this civil rights complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 against defendants Michael King, Justin Hudgins, Cody Rodgers, Joe Collins and T. Rigsby.

The court referred this matter to the Honorable Keith Giblin, United States Magistrate Judge, at Beaumont, Texas, for consideration pursuant to applicable laws and orders of this court. The Magistrate Judge recommends Defendants' Motion to Dismiss be granted.
