




In light of the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals' decision in *Robledo v. Leal*, USCA No. 12-10441, an unpublished opinion issued on June 21, 2013, this Court declines to adopt the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation filed on January 24, 2012, and finds that Plaintiff has stated claims of constitutional violations sufficient to require responsive pleadings from Defendants Correll, Wheat, Balderas, Sanchez, Zavala, Miles, and the TDCJ-CID.

It is, therefore, ORDERED:

1. A copy of this Order and Plaintiff's complaint shall be mailed to the Inmate Litigation Coordinator, Enforcement Division, P.O. Box 12548, Capitol Station, Austin, Texas 78711-2548, by certified mail, return receipt requested; and

2. Defendants Correll, Wheat, Balderas, Sanchez, Zavala, Miles, and the TDCJ-CID shall each file a written answer or other responsive pleading within thirty (30) days from the date the Inmate Litigation Coordinator receives this Order.
