**ORDER ADOPTING FINDINGS, CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATION
and DISMISSING PETITION FOR A WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS**

On December 26, 2017, petitioner filed with this Court a pleading entitled “Petition for Review” wherein he appeared to be attempting to initiate a federal habeas corpus proceeding challenging a state prison disciplinary decision. On January 9, 2018 petitioner filed an application to proceed *in forma pauperis* however, petitioner failed to submit a data sheet from the institution in which he is confined. On January 11, 2018, the United States Magistrate Judge ordered petitioner to submit his data sheet, giving him until January 31, 2018 to do so. Petitioner failed to comply with the Court’s Order.

On February 6, 2018, the United States Magistrate Judge issued findings, conclusions and a recommendation in this cause, recommending therein that this case be dismissed for want of prosecution. No objections to the Findings, Conclusions and Recommendation have been filed as of this date.

The undersigned United States Senior District Judge has made an independent examination of the record in this case. By failing to comply with the Court’s January 11, 2018

Order, petitioner has demonstrated a manifest lack of interest in litigating his claims. Consequently, the Magistrate Judge's Findings, Conclusions and Recommendation is hereby ADOPTED. Accordingly, the application for a writ of habeas corpus filed by petitioner is DISMISSED.
