ORDER ACCEPTING FINDINGS, CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATION

The United States Magistrate Judge made Findings, Conclusions, and a Recommendation in this case on Defendant’s Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. No. 40). No objections were filed. The District Court reviewed the proposed Findings, Conclusions, and Recommendation for plain error.
