Before me, the undersigned Notary Public, on this day personally appeared Ryan H. Zehl, a person known to me who, first being duly sworn on oath, deposed and stated:



needed to establish that the assertion of personal jurisdiction over Defendant is proper and in accordance with both established precedent and the Due Process Clause of the United States Constitution.

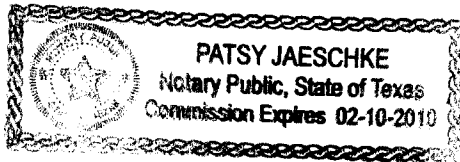
3. Both my clients and opposing counsel have consented to our requested extension.


