ORDER

Pursuant to the District Court’s Order (doc. 41), Defendant Virgin Mobile Pty Ltd.’s objection to making FED. R. CIV. P. 26(a)(1) disclosures, filed March 3, 2008, has been referred to the United States Magistrate Judge for hearing, if necessary, and to determine what disclosures, if any, are to be made, and to determine a time for disclosure. A hearing was held on April 10, 2008.
