ORDER OF THE COURT ON RECOMMENDATION REGARDING

- (X) The motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal is GRANTED.
- () the motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal is DENIED because movant has not shown that he is a pauper.

() Although this Court has denied movant permission to proceed with this case *in forma pauperis*, movant may challenge this finding pursuant to *Baugh v. Taylor*, 117 F. 3d 197 (5th Cir. 1997), by filing a separate motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal with the Clerk of Court, U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit, within 30 days of this order. *See also* Fed.
