## **CONDITIONAL TRANSFER ORDER (CTO -149)**

On May 23, 2011, the Panel transferred 3 civil action(s) to the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1407. The transmittal of this order to said Clerk shall be stayed 7 days from the entry thereof. Inasmuch as no objection is pending at this time, the stay is lifted.
