

**ORDER**

Before the Court are the Findings, Conclusions, and Recommendation of the United States Magistrate Judge advising that Plaintiff's Complaint, filed *pro se* and *in forma pauperis*, be dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)(ii).
